## Ten Titles of Christ in John Chapter One which Point to His **Deity**

John 1:29-41

These ten titles are all designations of Deity. No one but God can rightfully claim any of these titles:

- 1) Word (*John 1:1,14*). He is the One through whom God communicates and reveals Himself (*John 1:18*).
- **2)** Creator (*John 1:3*). Though the term "Creator" is not used, it is definitely implied since "All things were made by Him" and nothing was made without Him.
- 3) Life (John 1:4). Believers have life (1 John 5:12) but Christ  $\underline{is}$  Life (John 14:6). He is the true God and eternal life (1 John 5:20).
- **4)** Light (*John 1:4,5,7,8,9*). He is the Light of the world (*John 8:12*) and the Light of men (*John 1:4*).
- **5) Jehovah** (*John 1:23*). The Lord Jesus pointed to Himself as the fulfillment of Isaiah 40:3. The title "LORD" used in that prophecy is the Hebrew term "Jehovah," considered by the Jews to be the most sacred name of God. Jesus applied that name to Himself. He is Jehovah Jesus!
- **6) Lamb of God** (*John 1:29*). He was the sacrificial Lamb promised in Isaiah 53.
- **7) Son of God** (*John 1:34*). He is thus equal with God (*John 5:18*; 19:7).
- **8)** Messiah/Christ (*John 1:41*). He was God's anointed Prophet, Priest and King. He was the One Daniel spoke of in his 70 week prophecy (*Daniel 9:25-26*).
- 9) King of Israel (*John 1:49*). The world's government will be on this King's shoulders, and He will be called the Mighty God, the Prince of Peace (*Isaiah 9:6-7*). He shall reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there shall be no end (*Luke 1:33*).
- **10) Son of Man** (*John 1:51*). A clear designation of Deity when seen in light of Daniel 7:13-14 and Mark 14:61-64.
