The Awesome God of Wonders

Job 37:5-16

"In the secret of His presence How my soul delights to hide! Oh, how precious are the lessons Which I learn at Jesus' side" ~E. L. Goreh



The thirty-seventh chapter of Job speaks of the wonders of God as displayed in nature. In particular God's power and presence are evidenced through such natural events as thunderstorms, snowstorms, windstorms, etc. How we need to trust this awesome God in the midst of the storms that are raging around us in our day. In this chapter we shall briefly highlight four precious verses:

- 1) "Great things doth He which we cannot comprehend" (v. 5). We cannot begin to understand the mysterious workings of our God. "His ways are past finding out" (*Rom. 11:33*). He works all things, in perfect wisdom, after the counsel of His own will (*Eph. 1:11*). He does all things well (*Mark 7:37*).
- **2)** "Stand still, and consider the wondrous works of God" (v. 14). How we need to pause and meditate on the wonderful things that God does for our benefit and for His glory. "Come behold the works of the LORD....Be still and know that I am God" (*Psalm 46:8,10*).
- 3) "Dost thou know....the wondrous works of Him which is perfect in knowledge?" (v. 16). "As for God, His way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: He is a buckler to all those that trust in Him" (Psalm 18:30). God's perfect knowledge takes into account every factor and every circumstance in time and in eternity. He makes no mistakes.
- 4) "...the Almighty, we cannot find Him out: He is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice" (v. 23). From our limited viewpoint, we can never figure God out. We need to simply trust Him, rest in His all-wise plan, and allow God to be God.
