2 Corinthians 6:1-10

A paradox is a statement which is opposed to common sense and seems to say two opposite things. However,



- 1) The way up is the way down and the way down is the way up (*Matt. 23:12*).
- **2)** The one who finds his life loses it; the one who loses his life finds it (*Matt. 10:39*).
- **3)** An animal has rest when the yoke is off, but we find rest under a yoke (*Matt.* 11:28-29).
- **4)** The believer conquers by yielding (*Rom. 6:16-18*).
- **5)** The person who will be greatest, must be a servant of all (*Mark* 10:42-45).
- **6)** We are made free by becoming Christ's slaves (*Rom. 6:17-20*).
- **7)** We are strongest when we are weakest and weakest when we are strongest (2 Cor. 12:7-9).
- **8)** We have the most after we have given the most away (*Prov.* 11:24-25).
- **9)** We love supremely One we have never seen (1 Pet. 1:8).
- **10)** We are poor but we can make others rich (2 Cor. 6:10).
- **11)** We are sorrowful but always rejoicing (2 Cor. 6:10).
- **12)** We are perplexed, but not in despair (2 Cor. 4:8).
- **13)** We are persecuted but not forsaken (2 Cor. 4:9).
- **14)** We are cast down but not destroyed (2 Cor. 4:8).
- **15)** We are delivered unto death and yet we live (2 Cor. 4:10-11).
- **16)** We are as deceivers, and yet true (2 Cor. 6:8).
- **17)** We are unknown, yet well known (2 Cor. 6:9).
- **18)** We have nothing, yet we possess all things (2 Cor. 6:10).
- **19)** We walk on earth while seated in heaven (*Eph. 2:6*).
- **20)** We fear God but we are not afraid of Him (*Prov. 1:7*).
- **21)** We know we have been cleansed from sin, yet we know that in us is no good thing (*Rom.* 7:18).
