We want to study what these signs are and we want to test ourselves to see if these signs are really present in our lives. You need to get right with God. **2) You are spiritually dead.** That is, you are not a true believer and you don't have God's life. You may have *professed* salvation but you may never have *possessed* salvation. You need to receive Christ as your personal Saviour and trust in Him and Him alone (John 1:12; 6:47).

Sign of Life #1—A true believer BELIEVES the Word of God (1 John 5:9-12).


